### Important Dates

<b>Friday 07 February 2020</b>	Full deposit totalling £200 should be paid. Receipts are obtainable from the finance office by request.
<b>Thursday 30 April 2020</b>	We would appreciate that payment dates are adhered to in order to divide the cost of the visit over the year (full payments can be made at any time via cash, cheque or parent pay). An additional payment of <b>£200</b> is due by this date. This is <b>£400</b> in total.
<b>Before the visit</b>	Please be aware that the rules for travel to most countries in Europe may change now that the UK has left the EU. All students on the visit will need their <b>own passport</b> (which should have six months remaining on it from the day that students return from the visit) and <b>EHIC Card</b> therefore please make sure that they will be valid for the duration of the visit or renewed in good time.
<b>Friday 4 September 2020</b>	We would appreciate that payment dates are adhered to in order to divide the cost of the visit over the year (full or part payments can be made at any time via cash, cheque or parent pay). An additional payment of <b>£200</b> is due by this date. This is <b>£600</b> in total.
<b>Friday 30 October 2020</b>	Final payment date: Total amount now due: <b>£900</b>  Full or part payments can be made at any time via cash, cheque or parentmail.
<b>First week in November 2020</b>	Download clothing list and exercise sheet (optional) from the school website (skiing for four hours per day is demanding and even sporty people can get tired, increasing the risk of accidents. Students are advised to exercise regularly before the visit.)
<b>February 2021 (Date to be confirmed)</b>	Final information meeting and pre-visit briefing at school, 6:30pm start.
<b>Saturday 27 March April 2021</b>	Visit leaves for Austria.
<b>Sunday 04 April 2021</b>	Visit returns to school late afternoon/early evening, time to be confirmed.
