It was fantastic to see so many of you at the Year 9 Subject and Careers fair recently. Teaching colleagues from all subjects commented on the enthusiasm students have shown for the different courses available as part of our Key Stage 4 curriculum, and it has been great to see a large number of students and parents logging in to Start (www.startprofile.com) to help with their decision-making.

The Key Stage 4 curriculum process is now well underway. All students should have received their Key Stage 4 curriculum form from their tutor and a number of these have already been returned. Students should fill this in clearly and carefully, confirming their first and reserve choices. We ask all parents and carers to sign the document too so that we know any decision has been agreed at home. Please do not worry if your son or daughter has been given a form for a pathway that is a different colour to the pathway they are choosing from. Simply fill this in using the boxes provided and return to form tutors.

Student choices are not allocated on a first come first serve basis. However, it is important that all forms are returned by the deadline of **Monday 24 February 2020**.

As part of the process, we are delighted that Hull University are providing South Hunsley students with a Widening Participation event. This will take place on the afternoon of Wednesday 12 February 2020. To assist with their tracking of students and the measurement of the impact of this event, the University will collect the name, gender, date of birth, postcode and ethnicity of each student. This information is not used for any marketing purposes, shared or sold and is collected in line with school and university GDPR policies.

Later in the spring term, we will send another letter confirming the options we have recorded for each student. Where there are any issues with these options, we will speak to students directly.
