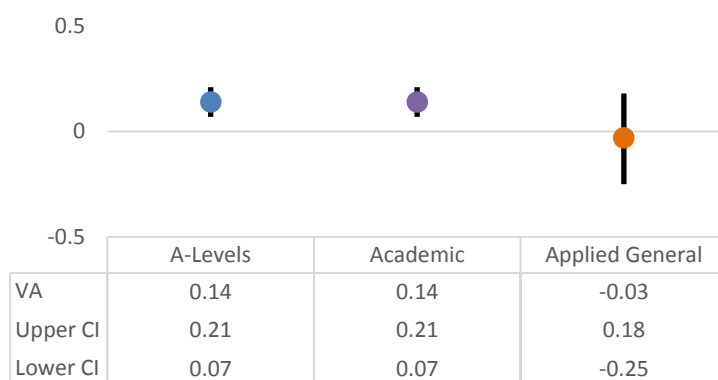


South Hunsley Sixth Form College 2016-17 KS5 Summary

Students at South Hunsley Sixth Form College studying post-16 qualifications have made significantly more progress than other students nationally. The progress made in applied general courses is in line with the national average.

The overall VA score for A-level, academic and vocational qualifications is shown in the chart below.

The retention figures above show the % of students who reach the end of the main programme of study that they enrolled on. These figures are expected to be above the local authority and national average, as in previous years.

Last year 98% of students finishing 16 to 18 study either stayed in education or training, or went into employment. As in previous years, this is expected to be above the local authority and national average.

English & Maths progress measure:

Students continuing to study GCSE English and Maths in the sixth made significant progress, compared to national.
