

Catering update

From September, we have had to review the options available for break and lunches. Our catering team have an excellent reputation for their freshly cooked and varied meals but under the new restrictions, hot meals will not be available

Due to the changes of the school day and the entries and exit restrictions will we no longer be able to offer breakfast in Riding Hall, we hope to reinstate this when new guidance comes out.

We have three designated eating areas; Riding Hall, The Space and the new Cube – each of these areas will offer identical food.

At their designated breaktimes they will be able to purchase the following which are all sealed

At their designated Lunchtime they will have the opportunity to purchase one of three grab bags

We will have several choices of drinks and they include Water, Flavoured Water and Milkshakes. There will be dressings available for the salads at an additional cost.

There will be no water fountains open so students should bring enough drink for the day or of course, they can purchase one at their designated break or lunch.

Biometric ID System
